### PRESS RELEASE

**THEFT:** A contractor working at Carlucci's restaurant in the 800 block of Centerton Road reported a theft. Two outdoor decorative lamps and a power saw, valued at \$1400, were taken. The incident occurred sometime between 10:00 PM, August 18, and 6:00 AM, August 19.

**ARREST (CREDIT CARD FRAUD):** Mount Laurel Police arrested Clintisha H. Lewis, age 20, of Brooklyn, New York, on August 19 for credit card fraud, possession of fraudulent documents, and hindering arrest. She was arrested after she attempted to use a fraudulent credit card to make a purchase at PC Richard and Son on Nixon Drive. She was served with criminal complaints and lodged in the Burlington County Jail after failing to post \$10,000.00 bail. Officer J. Krusieski was the arresting officer.

**BURGLARY:** A resident of the 5000 block of Church Road reported a burglary and theft to a residence. The incident occurred between 5:00 PM August 19 and 7:30 AM August 20. Entry was gained by forcing open a door. Power tools, valued at approximately \$450.00, were taken.
