### **THREE MEN ARRESTED FOR SEXUAL ACTIVITY WITH 15-YEAR-OLD GIRL THEY MET ONLINE**

Burlington County Prosecutor Robert D. Bernardi and Mount Laurel Police Chief Dennis A. Cribben Jr. announced today that three men have been arrested for engaging in sexual activity with a 15-year-old Mount Laurel girl who made her personal information available to them through online social networking sites.

The investigation revealed that the minor had socialized online with each man before arrangements were made to meet in person. She then met each defendant separately on more than one occasion at a location in Mount Laurel. The sexual activity occurred inside the vehicles of the defendants between February and April of this year.

The investigation began after one of the minor's parents contacted law enforcement authorities and provided detectives with her cell phone and iPod Touch capable of accessing the Internet.

A detective from the Prosecutor's Office then assumed the identity of the minor and made contact with the defendants through numerous text messages wherein each defendant agreed to meet with who they believed was the minor. They were arrested on separate dates upon showing up for what they believed would be yet another sexual encounter with the minor.

The investigation was conducted by detectives from the Mount Laurel Police Department and the Burlington County Prosecutor's Office Sexual Assault/Child Abuse Unit.

All three cases will now be presented to a Burlington County Grand Jury for indictment.

"When children leave the house and go out into the world, their parents – at the very least – should find out where they are headed, what they will be doing and who they will be with," Prosecutor Bernardi said. "That same scrutiny should be applied to online activities. I can't emphasize too strongly the need for parents to involve themselves in this area of their children's lives. Parents must know what their children are doing whenever they use any device that can electronically connect them to others."

Those arrested include:

**John O. Goins III**, age 28, of 36 Twilight Lane, Willingboro, NJ. Goins was arrested on April 28, 2011 and charged with Sexual Assault (Second Degree), Attempted Sexual Assault (Second Degree) Criminal Sexual Contact (Fourth Degree), Debauching the Morals of a Minor (Third Degree) and Obstructing Justice. Goins was released after posting \$125,000 bail.

**Dorence Y. Caulker**, age 33, of 84 Kingsbridge Drive, Lumberton, NJ. Caulker was arrested on May 5, 2011 and charged with two counts of Sexual Assault (Second Degree), three counts of Debauching the Morals of a Minor (Third Degree), and Criminal Sexual Contact (Fourth Degree). Caulker is in the Burlington County Jail on \$300,000 full bail.

**Matthew M. Sadowski**, age 26, of 6 Compass Circle, Mount Laurel, NJ. Sadowski was arrested May 17, 2011 and charged with two counts of Sexual Assault (Second Degree), Attempted Sexual Assault (Second Degree) and three counts of Debauching the Morals of a Minor (Third Degree). Sadowski was released after posting \$100,000 bail.
